



Thank you for your interest in our Adopt-a-Senior program. It provides many necessary items for nearly 400 (mostly homebound) Clermont County senior citizens. There are several ways in which you can help. They are:

1. **Adopt-a-Senior:** Donors receive a senior's first name and ID number, along with a "wish list". The list is just a suggestion of gifts. **Donors attach a card with the ID number on each of the packages.** Gifts are delivered to customers mostly by staff, and some prescreened volunteers. Donors can drop gifts off at our main office at 2085 James E. Sauls Sr. Drive (next to the Clermont YMCA) between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.; or our Union Township Senior Center located in the Union Township Civic Center at 4350 Aicholtz Road.
2. **Purchase Gift Pantry Items:** Donors/groups purchase personal care items, cleaning supplies, plastic buckets, or household items such as towels & wash cloths, sheets and pillow cases of all sizes, generic clothing (socks, mittens/gloves (one size fits all), pet food (5 lb. bags or less), craft supplies, etc. Other needed items include night-gowns (all sizes), diabetic socks (all sizes), bathrobes (all sizes), etc. Field staff and case managers can then "shop" for their customers from the items donated. Cleaning supplies are stored and used year round.
3. **Donate Gift Bags:** Donors put together their own gift bags filled with sweet treats or personal care items for either a man or a woman. Be sure to mark the gender on a card attached to bag.
4. **Make a Cash Donation:** used to purchase grocery gift cards or large tag items (mattress, recliner, etc.).

Please **drop off** your items by **December 10**. The earlier you drop off your donations, the more likely it is that we will get them to the seniors by Christmas. After December 10, please drop off all donations at our office. Clermont Senior Services is **CLOSED on Friday, December 23**.
