The Home Repair Program provides minor home repairs and home modifications to eligible homeowners. Services are to improve, restore, or maintain a clean, sanitary and safe living environment.

Eligibility

- Seniors 60 years old or older
- Resident of Clermont County
- Repairs will only be provided to owner occupied homes
- Household income must be under 250% of poverty guidelines

Services

- Maximum of three minor repair or one major repair per year, per household.
- Experienced Volunteers and paid contractors provide labor

Costs for services and Materials Cost

- Donations are requested based on income.
- Homeowners are responsible for all material cost.
- Grant assistance may be available for hardship cases and emergencies.

	Minor Plumbing (faucets, toilets, water leaks, unclog small drains, not whole house drains)	Roof coat on Mobile home (every 5 yrs)	No cosmetic improvements
	Minor electrical repairs, replace switches, outlets, and thermostat.	Temporary measures to cover roof/window/ doors for safety while repair can be arranged.	
	Furnace repairs (emergency calls for low income customers with no heat)	Flooring repair (small areas only must be safety related)
